5. Be Water Wise - in your holiday accommodation, please turn off the tap when brushing your teeth and adhere to towel policies or other water saving initiatives.
6. Conserve Energy - always switch off lights and preserve heat by closing windows whenever you leave your hotel room.
7. Respect Nature - help us to look after the landscape and wildlife by not littering, guarding against fire and using footpaths and cycle-ways responsibly. Ensure you follow the Countryside Code when out in the Cotswolds.
