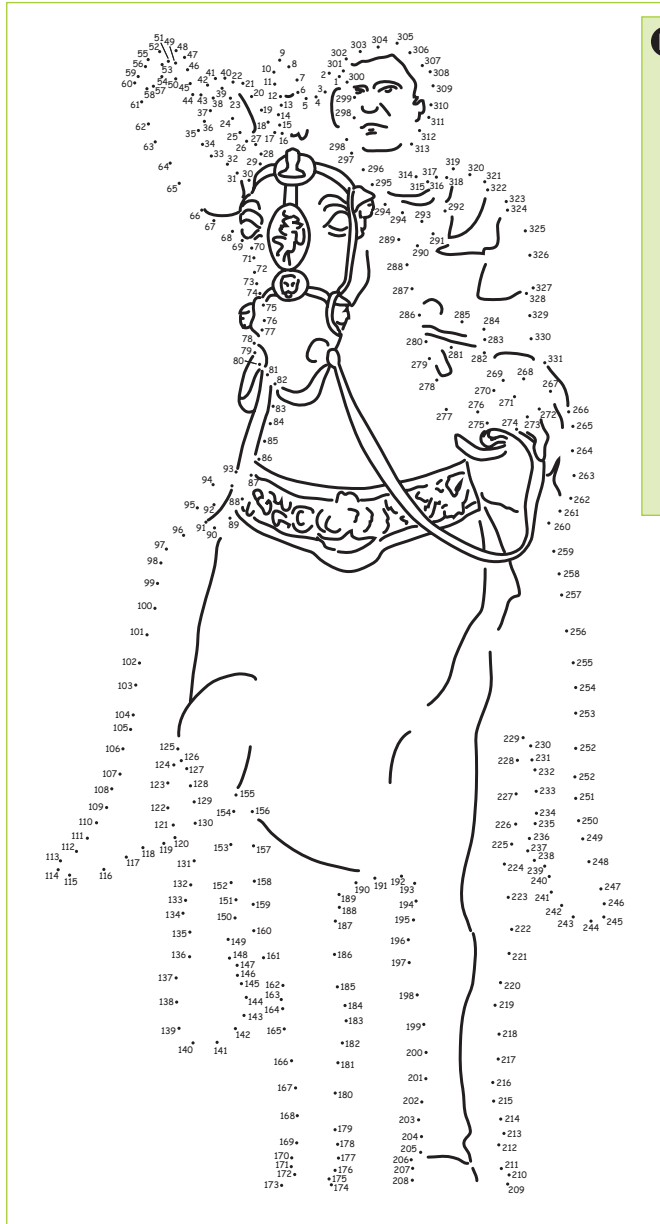
We hope you enjoy the walk.

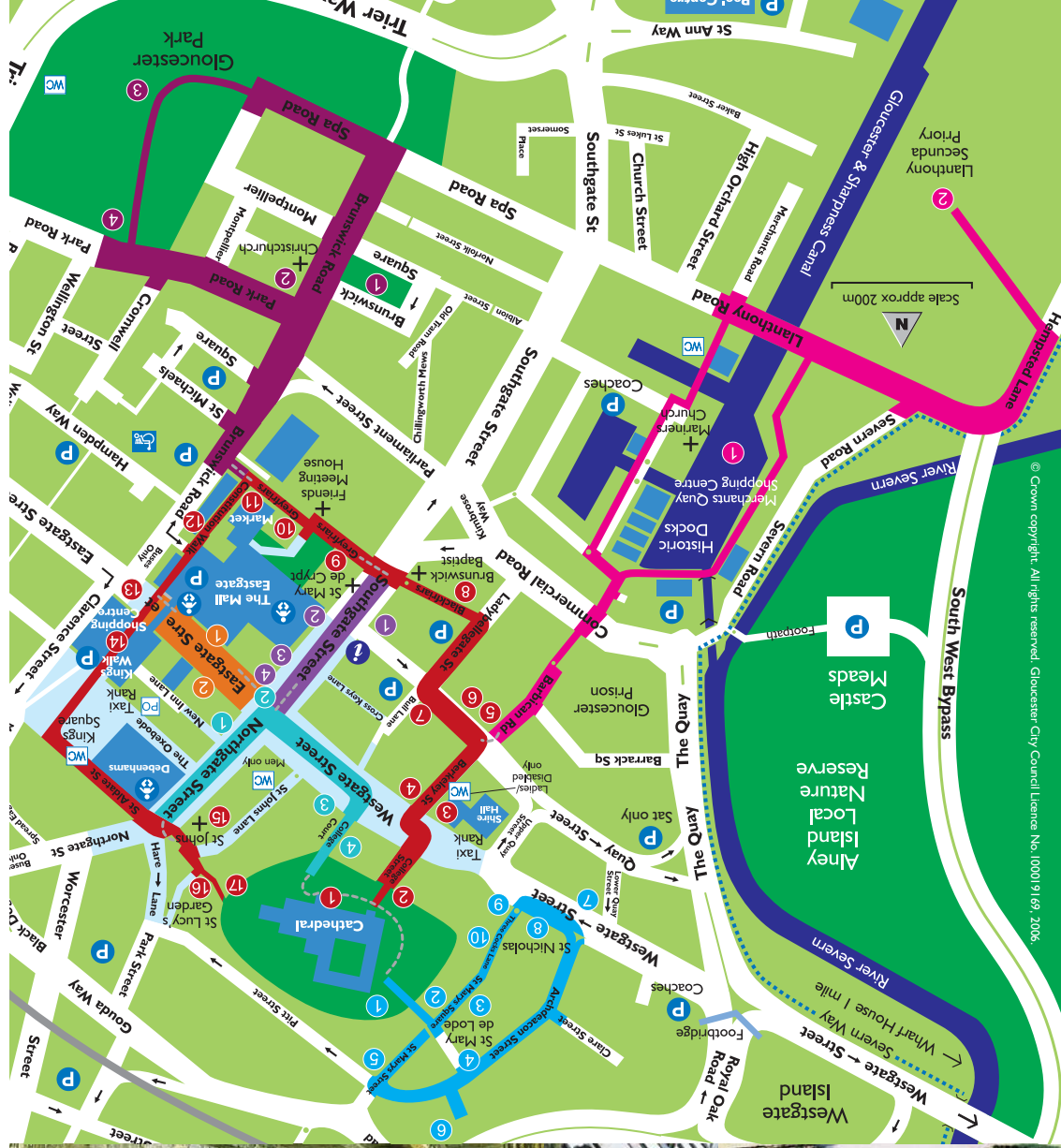

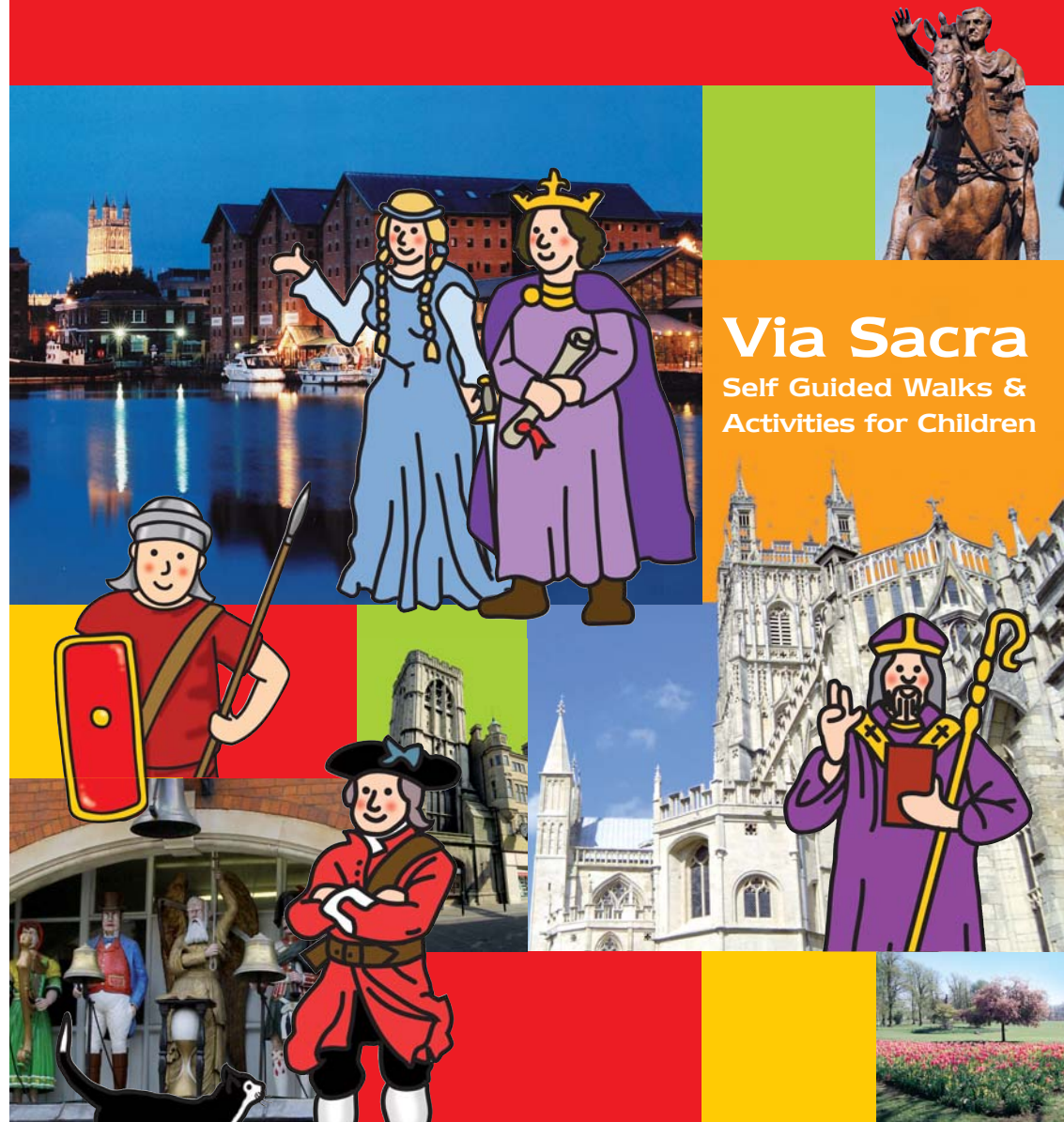
